World Communications Day

World Communications Day was established by Pope Paul VI in 1967, and it is usually celebrated on the Sunday before Pentecost. It is an annual celebration that encourages reflection on the opportunities and challenges that the media offers and how the Church can better engage the tools to communicate the Gospel message in every age. Pope Francis has announced the theme for 2025 World Communication Day (WCD). The theme is, “Share with gentleness the hope that is in your hearts” (cf. 1Pt 3:15-16). With this theme for the 59th WCD celebration, scheduled for Sunday 1 June, the Holy Father calls on Christians and non Christians alike; to re-examine the way they communicate with one other. What might happen if each of us were to take one action to increase unity, trust and stability in our world? The following prayer was offered by Pope Francis in 2018.

Lord, make us instruments of your peace.
 Help us to recognize the evil latent in a communication that does not build communion.
 Help us to remove the venom from our judgements.
 Help us to speak about others as our brothers and sisters.
 You are faithful and trustworthy; may our words be seeds of goodness for the world:
 where there is shouting, let us practice listening;
 where there is confusion, let us inspire harmony;
 where there is ambiguity, let us bring clarity;
 where there is exclusion, let us offer solidarity;
 where there is sensationalism, let us use sobriety;
 where there is superficiality, let us raise real questions;
 where there is prejudice, let us awaken trust;
 where there is hostility, let us bring respect;
 where there is falsehood, let us bring truth. Amen

Mid-Year CAR

Attention: Conference Presidents and Treasurers Mid-Year Conference Activity Report (CAR) Balancing (Due 5/7/2025)

Each conference is required to run a CAR for the period 10/1/2024 to 3/31/2025. Conferences should have received instructions and audited conference ending balances from their District Council President. Please request assistance from your DC President, as needed. This action is being required by Larry, Council CFO, to avoid issues at the end of the fiscal year that could delay our annual reporting timeline.

Conference Grant Proposal Approval Policy

Many conferences write grants to various entities and for various needs. Conferences are under the St. Vincent de Paul Archdiocese of Santa Fe IRS nonprofit status so in order to ensure that these grants follow the Rule of the Society, **all grant proposals must be submitted to the ASF Council Board for approval prior to submission to**

granting entity. Conferences should allow a minimum of two (2) weeks for written ASF Council Board approval.

Policy approved by ASF Council Board on October 27, 2023

A Note from our CFO

Conferences are reminded the Archdiocese Council has a Capital Purchase policy that applies to all conferences. The policy requires that any purchase that equals to or exceeds \$2,500 must be approved by the Council Board prior to committing to expending the funds. These requests must be supported by three estimates or an explanation why three estimates cannot be obtained. This applies to the purchases of equipment and facility improvements/repairs. This policy applies even if the funds for the purchase will be provided by a grant. It does not apply to expenses directly related to serving our neighbors such as equipment rental for special events and such. Requests and questions should be directed to Larry Gonzales (svdplarry@gmail.com). Note: While equipment provided directly to a conference through a grant (no cash outlay by SVDP) does not require board approval, equipment that is valued at \$2,500 or more must be documented and reported to the CFO.

- Home Visit & Service Delivery
- Spirituality & Core Values
- Membership & Recruitment

• Communication & Outreach

We will receive instructions and materials in mid May. Groups will work through the summer and provide recommendations to the Council in early September. The Council will create a Working Group that will take up all submitted recommendations and create **one** Council Report of Recommendations and Actions for **each of the five** themes above. This needs to be completed by December 1, 2025.

The Council will then elect two Delegates to the National VisionSVdP Congress, to be held in the first Quarter of 2026. These Delegates cannot be the NCM, and one Delegate **should** hold no Office at the Council or Conference level if possible. All expenses for the Congress will be paid by the National Council. The Congress is anticipated to be three days of intensive work and will develop a final set of recommendations and actions.
